The NJPPC is dedicated to supporting primary care physicians and sub-specialists in integrating mental/behavioral health care into their patients' well and sick visits.

## Here is how the NJPPC can support you, your practice, and your patients:

### Consultative Support and Referral

- Licensed mental health professionals (e.g., LCSWs & LPCs), to assist with identification and assessment of symptoms and care coordination
- "Curbside Consults with a CAP\*", for diagnostic clarification or treatment initiation/management
- One-time psychiatric evaluation (as warranted by the CAP) with ongoing collaboration for cases seen

*\*Child and Adolescent Psychiatrist*

### Training and Quality Improvement

- Continuous education opportunities in screening, management, treatment and care coordination of common child and adolescent mental/behavioral health issues
- Webinar and Learning Collaborative topics include: ADHD, depression, anxiety, suicidal thinking & behavior, among others
- Monthly opportunities to obtain CME credit/ MOC part 2 points

### Tele-Psychiatry in your Practice

- Registered providers are eligible to receive a free iPad to implement tele-psychiatry and Curbside with a CAP services
- Patients referred and eligible for a CAP evaluation can access appointments via:
  - Tele-psychiatry at their home or in their provider's office
  - In-person at Hub office
