Louisiana Provider to Provider Consultation Line (PPCL) For Pediatric Mental Health Support

The Provider-to-Provider Consultation Line (PPCL) is a no-cost telehealth consultation and education program that helps pediatric health care providers address the behavioral and mental health needs of their patients ages 0-21. The program aims to increase the capacity to screen, diagnose, treat, and refer patients to supportive services by integrating behavioral health into the pediatric primary care setting and connecting providers to mental health consultants and psychiatrists.

What Does the Program Offer?



Consultation on diagnoses, medications and psychotherapy interventions for a wide range of behavioral health needs (e.g. mental health care guides, screening forms)



Guidance on pediatric behavioral health issues, autism spectrum disorders, intellectual and developmental disabilities and more through a TeleECHO series



Resources to connect with community partners and agencies (e.g. intensive in-home providers, support groups)
